

Once again, the Word of God proves relevant because that is exactly how we all feel!

Our Father has just brought us through the most amazing unpredicted month in the history of our fellowship. We know the burning question is "When can we begin our normal worship services again!?" Well, as you know our services have never really been normal, but we are working on a plan for

our "re-opening" now and have some announcements for you. There will be no changes for the first weekend in May. Everything will be online live at 10:45am on YouTube, Facebook, and radio on 97.1FM, 94.1FM and 1400AM. We plan to continue all of these platforms even after we come back together.

On Mother's Day, May 10, we would like to invite any of you who are interested to come sit in the parking lot and listen via radio or your phone during the service. Immediately following the service, we will come to the parking lot exits and have a gift for mothers as you leave. As soon as our governor and state leaders adjust distancing requirements to allow 50% capacity in our buildings, we will begin having two services on Sunday mornings. The first service will be at 9am followed by a service at our regular 10:45 time. Anyone is welcome at either service, but we recommend that our senior adults and those who are physically vulnerable attend the early service and that we all be patient and sensitive to individual distancing concerns. There will be no childcare or Sunday School for the first few weeks, but we will begin to implement those incrementally. With the way things stand at the present, those services will not begin until Sunday, May 24th, but that is subject to change. We will do everything we can to keep you informed as the Lord gives us direction. Remember, each church in our area has unique logistical considerations, so no two churches will have the same plan of action. Continue to pray for us as we work with pastors in our area and strive to hear the Lord's plan for our fellowship. Please share this information with anyone you know who has been missing our services or who may not get this e-mail newsletter.

Pastor Corey, Pastor Mike and I will continue to broadcast daily at noon our program "Resting in the Refuge". Currently you will find it on our Facebook page. Resting in the Refuge is 30 minutes of encouragement from the Scriptures and prayer together. You can stay connected by commenting in your prayer needs and others can join you in prayer over these as they view the program as well.

We want to thank those of you who have been so faithful in your tithing. Because of your faithful giving, not only have we been able to keep up all of our missions commitments, but God has put us in the position to help provide much needed resources for the Haven Home (a special needs adult living center), to help an area bivocational pastor and his family with financial needs and also to partner with Redwater High School in providing a special tribute for the graduating class of 2020. It has been so encouraging to see your commitment and support. The online giving is also available on the church website at fbcredwater.org and is now easier than ever to find.

Let us encourage you now to continue to BE THE CHURCH. Now is your time to shine! Continue praying for the sick, as well as the anxious and fearful. Be active in praying for your pastors and leaders, including our national leaders. Be active in pursuing your personal relationship with the Lord. Be still. Listen. Obey. 
