Psalm 90:13-17

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

During March, there will be bushel baskets across the front of the Sanctuary, across the front the stage. Any food items that you bring can be placed in these baskets and will be taken to Mission Texarkana at the end of the month.

Are you at a loss for what to bring? Want to bring items that are most desired or needed? Here is a list of ideas about what nonperishable food items you can bring to donate:

canned meats, canned fish, canned nuts, peanut butter, jelly, boxed macaroni and cheese mixes, spaghetti noodles, dried peas, beans, bread mix, oatmeal, dry cereal, rice, boxed meals like Hamburger Helper or Rice A Roni, grits, powdered milk, evaporated milk, canned soup, canned fruits, canned vegetables, canned juices, canned spaghetti sauce and any other nonperishable food item
